



FOOD HYGEINE & SAFETY LEVEL 2 CERTIFICATION

Who's This For:

- If learners are involved (or are going to be involved) with food preparation in a catering, manufacturing or retail capacity, they will need to undertake **Level 2 Food Safety and Hygiene** training.
- This Course and Certification is the recommended basic requirement for anyone working in a role that involves the actual handling or preparation of food.
- Anyone who manages staff members in a catering environment
- Includes anyone working in Hotels, Camps, Restaurants, Takeaways, Cafes, Bars, Fast food outlets, Kitchens, Hospitals, Prisons, Schools and Colleges

COMPLIANCE & LEGISLATION

- This Level 2 Food Safety and Hygiene for Catering course is designed to help you comply with EU Regulation 852/2004, which requires food businesses to ensure that any employee who handles food is fully trained in food hygiene. The contents of this course also adhere to the Industry Standards set by People 1st and the Sector Skills Council for the Hospitality, Leisure, Travel and Tourism industries.
- The course includes all the latest legislation, information and up-to-date guidance
- This certification is universally recognised and can be used to provide evidence of food hygiene and safety training both internally and to external auditors. There is no set time for how long a certificate is valid for, but the accepted industry standard is for food hygiene certificates to be renewed every three years.

TO BECOME CERTIFIED

- The course will take approx. 3-4hrs
- The first 2hrs will involve interactive practical instruction followed by a test
- Candidates will need to complete a test that consists of 30 multiple choice questions. Learners are required to achieve a 75% pass mark, and - if necessary - may attempt the test three times at no extra cost.
- Each student will receive a hologrammed Certificate - CPD Certified | City and Guilds | Meets UK / EU Food Handlers Training Requirement (within 14 days)
- Renewal after 3yrs is done by re-sitting the exam, if unable to attain 75% the candidate will have to re-do the training once again
